

RECYCLING IS OPEN TO RESIDENTS OF WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP ONLY

The Washington Township Environmental Advisory Council (EAC) is primarily responsible for running the Red Barn Recycling Center for the Township. Our key objective is to keep the public and the volunteers SAFE while providing recycling services to the township. The new procedures require your PATIENCE in following these procedures:

The public and our volunteers MUST WEAR MASKS.

All Materials MUST BE SORTED. Volunteers will not be sorting.

Cars will form a line into the facility.

The first 2 cars will drop off their recyclables NEXT to the front barn door. The public may NOT enter the barn.

Drop off the following separated items at the front of the Red Barn:

- #1 plastics (PETE)
- #2 plastics (HDPE)
- aluminum
- mixed paperboard, glass, steel, and plastics #5 through #8

Vehicles then drive to the rear of the barn. And the next 2 cars in line pull up to the front of the Red Barn.

Drop off the following separated items at the rear of the Red Barn:

- paper materials (newspapers, office paper, mail, shredded paper, catalogs) in the outside Paper Retriever container
- flattened cardboard next to the rear door of the Red Barn

Cars exit through the Public Works gates.

Please consider volunteering to keep the barn open. If we can't find enough people to man the facility, it will not be open that day.
