The Washington Township Sewer Department is located at 120 Barto Road and is in the administration building for the Township. Washington Township owns and operates a 0.25 mgd sewage treatment plant located on Niantic Road near Route 100, and also owns and operates a collection and conveyance system that, as of the end of 2020, served households and businesses totaling 1000 equivalent dwelling units (EDU's) in the southeastern portion of the Township, including 48 EDU's connected to the Bally sewer system. Sanitary sewer inquiries, including questions regarding quarterly bills, should be directed to customer service at telephone number 610-845-3697.

RATES

The Township's sanitary sewer systems services approximately 1000 accounts. Residential accounts are charged a sewer service rental rate of \$318.29 per quarter OR \$1273.16 annually. In addition, new connections to the sanitary sewer system pay a one time tapping fee of \$9,700.00 per equivalent dwelling unit (EDU) and commercial customers are charged additional EDU's based on estimated flow.
