SUBDIVISION REVIEW

Margaret M. Stauffer Minor Plan – Submitted 9/25/19. Mr. John Aston was present this evening to discuss the Margaret M. Stauffer Minor Plan and explained the existing area of the house is 1.8 acres and the existing area of the other ground is 7.7 acres. It is their desire to make the house area 3 acres leaving about 6.5 acres. Mr. Aston stated there are concrete monuments proposed at the lot lines in the front of the property but are asking a waiver of having to set additional concrete monuments. A motion was made by Frank Gehringer and seconded by Romnie Long recommending the waiver of two monuments in favor of pins. No comments received.

A general comment on the LTL Review letter referenced a shed which is partially located on the adjoining lands and suggested the owner should consider relocating the shed to avoid potential future conflicts. Mr. Stauffer talked about the proposed rental ordinance and stated there was an article in the Pottstown Mercury regarding a rental ordinance in Pottstown. Mr. Stauffer read some of the article titled "Pottstown suffers loss in court battle over rental inspections". Ms. London explained one issue was the fact that they were not inspecting the property at the time of vacancy or change of tenant but rather periodically with the tenant still living at the property. Also, there were no clear parameters as to what the code official was looking for and anything that the code official saw that seamed to be evidence of some form of criminal activity could that be referred to the police. Ms. London stated that a well drafted ordinance will survive especially if the inspection is done during vacancy.
