

**WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP BOARD OF SUPERVISORS
WORKSHOP MEETING MINUTES
MAY 9, 2024**

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Thomas Powanda called the Washington Township Board of Supervisors Workshop meeting to order at 7:02 p.m., at the Washington Township Municipal Building. The meeting opened with the Pledge of Allegiance.

SUPERVISORS

- **Public Works garage project site work**-Tom Unger reported a meeting was held yesterday to review the site work proposal from Gorski Engineering. Attending the meeting were Jerry Gorski, Joe Pugliese, and Austin Dietrich, Gorski Engineering, Tom Unger, SDEI and Susan Brown and Brian Mohr. The site work proposal came in at \$86,500; the removal of the following items brought the price to \$50,153:
 - Install Concrete Washout \$ 2,360.00
 - Remove Concrete Washout \$ 2,560.00
 - Install roof drainage w/rain leaders 6" \$18,592.00
 - Install Rip Rap \$ 1,008.00
 - Replace topsoil to site & grade \$ 8,127.00
 - Rake, seed and mulch lawn area \$ 3,700.00

A motion was made by Romnie Long, seconded by Thomas Powanda accepting the bid proposal from Gorski Engineering as outlined above for a price of \$50,153.

David Moyer - opposed

There was discussion regarding the aprons for the building. The Supervisors want to have something in writing regarding the installation of aprons at the two (2) man doors and the garage bay doors. Tom Unger will contact Gorski to make this request.
