SUPERVISORS UNFINISHED BUSINESS

2025 Road Project (County Line Road) base repairs

The Oil and Chip Project is scheduled to begin on County Line Rd. A quote from Sacks to complete the base repairs was \$96,000.00. It was decided the Roadcrew will complete the base repairs and will rent equipment from Sacks at a cost not to exceed \$50,000.

A motion was made by Thomas Powanda and seconded by Rommie Long to authorize the rental of equipment from Sacks & Sons not to exceed \$50,000.00 for the completion of base repairs for County Line Road.

Sewer Capacity Reduction Agreement for EBFD

The EBFD has requested authorization to transfer two (2) additional unused EDU's they currently own, as part of the property purchased at 1200 Route 100, to their vacant parcel located across Route 100. The land is under contract and is scheduled to go to closing on Monday. This brings the total number of EDU's to three (3) on the vacant property.

A motion was made by David Moyer and seconded by Thomas Powanda to authorize the transfer of two (2) unused EDU's from their property at 1200 Old Rt 100 to their vacant land along Route 100.
