

**WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP
BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA**

ORDINANCE NO. 2025-1

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WASHINGTON, BERKS COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA, TO AMEND THE WASHINGTON TOWNSHIP, CODE OF ORDINANCES, CHAPTER 125, ENTITLED "VEHICLES AND TRAFFIC," ARTICLE III, ENTITLED "PARKING," SECTION 125-14, ENTITLED "PARKING PROHIBITED," AND SECTION 125-15 ENTITLED "SIGNS TO BE ERECTED," TO PROHIBIT PARKING ALONG THE EAST SIDE OF VICTORIA DRIVE, FROM NIAN TIC ROAD TO THE FIRST RESIDENCE AND TO DIRECT SIGNS PROHIBITING PARKING BE ERECTED.

WHEREAS, the Township of Washington, Berks County, Pennsylvania ("Township") is a municipal corporation organized and existing under the laws of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania ("Commonwealth"), including but not limited to the Second-Class Township Code:

WHEREAS, under the Second-Class Township Code and the Pennsylvania Vehicle Code, the Township may regulate traffic on Township Streets;

WHEREAS, the Township desires to amend the Washington Township Code of Ordinances to prohibit parking along the East side of Victoria Drive, from Niantic Road to the first residence.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED by the Township Supervisors of the Township of Washington, Berks County, Pennsylvania and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the authority of the same as follows:

SECTION 1. The Code of Ordinances of the Township of Washington, Chapter 125 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic," Article III, entitled "Parking," Section 125-14, entitled "Parking Prohibited," is hereby amended to add a new subsection E to prohibit parking along the East side of Victoria Drive, from Niantic Road to the first residence, as follows:

§125-14 Parking prohibited.

Parking is hereby prohibited:

- A. Along the West side of Pennsylvania Legislative Route 100 from a point 150 feet North of the center line of Dairy Lane to a point 300 feet South of the center line of said Dairy Lane and along the East side of Pennsylvania Legislative Route 100 from a point 150 feet North of the center line of Niantic Road to a point 210 feet South of the center line of said Niantic Road in Washington Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania.
- B. Along the East side of Route 100 from a point 150 feet North of the center line of Passmore Road to a point 170 feet South of the center line of

Passmore Road and on the West side of Route 100 from a point 150 feet North of the center line of Limekiln to a point 170 feet South of the center line of Limekiln Road, in Washington Township, Berks County, Pennsylvania.

- C. On both sides of Forgedale Road beginning at a point 50 feet North of Pole No. DH 442, which is approximately 500 feet North of the intersection of Anthony's Mill Road and Forgedale Road, and ending at Pole No. DH 448, a distance of approximately 1,300 feet, in the Township of Washington, Berks County, Pennsylvania.
- D. On both sides of Cubbler Court along the entire length of Cubbler Court.
- E. Along the East side of Victoria Drive, from Niantic Road to the first residence known as 90 Victoria Drive, Property ID No. 89630903124865.

SECTION 2. The Code of Ordinances of the Township of Washington, Chapter 125 entitled "Vehicles and Traffic," Article III, entitled "Parking," Section 125-15, entitled "Signs to be Erected," is hereby amended to direct official no-parking signs to be erected along the roads in the prohibited areas designated by Section 125-14, as follows:

§ 125-15 Signs to be erected.

The proper Township official shall cause official no-parking signs to be erected along roads in the prohibited areas designated by § 125-14 above facing traffic traveling in the direction affected by this article.

SECTION 3. All ordinances or parts of ordinances conflicting with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. The provisions of this Ordinance are severable. If any clause, sentence, subsection or section hereof shall be adjudged by any court of competent jurisdiction to be illegal, invalid or unconstitutional, such judgment or decision shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this Ordinance, but shall be confined in its operation and application to the clause, sentence, subsection or section rendered. It is hereby declared the intent of Township Board of Supervisors that this Ordinance would have been adopted if such illegal, invalid or unconstitutional clause, sentence, subsection or section had not been included herein.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall become effective upon enactment.

SECTION 6. The Code of Ordinances of the Township of Washington, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, shall be and remain unchanged and in full force and effect except as amended, supplemented and modified by this Ordinance, including but not limited to any and all other fines and costs for violations of traffic, parking, and snow emergency regulations. This Ordinance shall become a part of the Code of Ordinances of the Township of Washington, Berks County, Pennsylvania, as amended, upon adoption.
