- 2026 Road Project change order – Roadmaster Brian Mohr stated that a leveling/scratch course was not included in the bid specifications for the 2026 Road Project and explained that the leveling course is necessary to ensure the smoothness of the road when it is completed. Unfortunately, it is too late to do a leveling course on Stauffer Road, however Brian is requesting that a leveling course be added to the scope of work on Barto Road and Kulps Road.

A motion was made by Tom Powanda and seconded by Matt McCluskey authorizing the change order to the scope of work for the 2026 Road Project to include a leveling course to Barto Road and Kulps Road at a price per ton of \$120.34 for Barto Road and \$104.20 for Kulps Road.
